INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS MEAL MINISTRY

Our CCO partner Dolly Dong has informed us that a number of international students remain on campus and need cared for during this stressful time. Many of them are homesick and dealing with mental health challenges as a result of the uncertain climate in which we find ourselves.

Dolly is organizing an effort to provide meals to approximately 50 students twice per week starting Tuesday, March 17. Funds have been secured for this effort. Dolly is requesting that we recruit **3-4 volunteers** who will deliver meals to international students. Dolly and other helpers will have the meals prepared and packaged; only delivery is needed. Meal delivery will take place on **Tuesdays** and **Thursdays**; volunteers will be asked to arrive at the church at 11 am and be given instructions for delivery.
